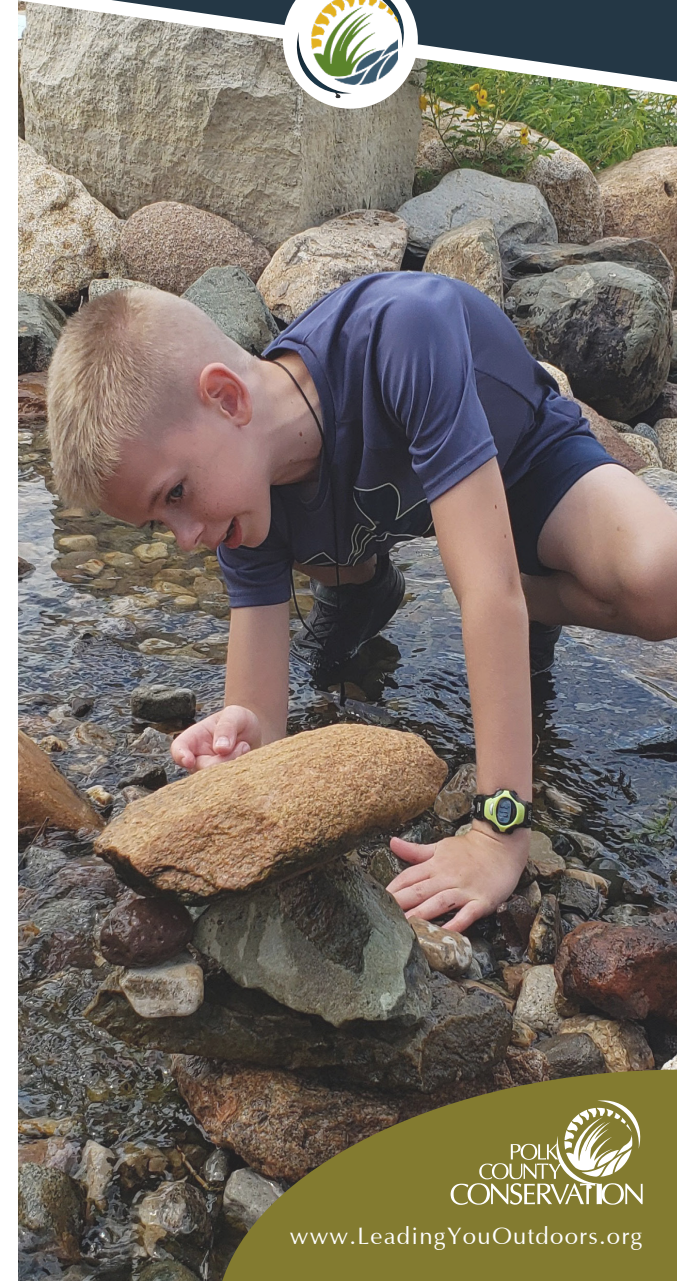

# BECOME AN IOWA JUNIOR NATURALIST!

## Welcome

This program allows anyone, ages 6-18, to enjoy the outdoors with professional guidance and family participation. The Iowa Junior Naturalist program is offered by Polk County Conservation and other conservation agencies.

This program is offered each calendar year and encourages youth and adults to attend environmental education programs and embark on independent outdoor activities together.



## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

### Public Programs

Participants must attend **three** different public programs. Examples include: guided hikes, monarch tagging events, stargazing programs, or any other public, nature related program.

### Independent Activities

Participants 6-12 years old must complete **two** independent activities. Examples include: reading a nature book, going fishing, camping, hiking, or other nature related activity. For participants 13-18 years old, one of these activities must be a formal volunteer commitment totalling one or more hours toward a public conservation event.

### Awards

All of the above requirements must be completed within one calendar year. Upon completion, participants will receive a colorful Iowa Junior Naturalists patch and certificate of achievement.
