<p>EXAMPLE STEPS:</p> <p>1) At month end, record the "Month".</p> <p>2) Record how much "Paint/solvent used for the month".</p> <p>3) Record any "waste disposal for the month"</p> <p>4) Subtract column 3 from column 2 and record in column 4</p> <p>5) After 12 months, add the gallons in column 4 for the previous 12 months and record it in column 5 for the month just ending. This is the 12 month rolling total. <p>For this example, 12 months is reached in April-20, and that is the start of the rolling 12-month totals. Add the "Total paint/solvent used for the month" in column 4 from May-19 through April-20, (4+1+2+6+3+0+5+3+1+1+0+9=35) and record in in column 4, "12 month rolling total". May-20 would be determined in the same manner just shifting one month, June-19 through May-20 and so on.</p> <p>A "12 month rolling total" is NOT the same as a "Calendar Year" total. Your facility is required to keep a "12 Month Rolling Month" total and submit it with your "Annual Operating Permit Application"</p>
