

SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS & CHILDREN

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program serves **infants** and **children** up to their sixth birthday; and **women** who are pregnant or have given birth in the past 12 months.

A person must reside within the geographical boundaries of Polk, Dallas, Warren, Jasper Madison, and Boone Counties. A person must meet the income standards for benefits under existing Federal, State, or local food, health, or welfare programs for low-income persons; or meet the following income eligibility guidelines established by the United States Department of Agriculture.

FOODS RECEIVED: Infant cereal; infant formula; evaporated milk; non-fat dry milk; rice, macaroni, or spaghetti; ready-to-eat cereal, farina, or oatmeal; peanut butter or dry beans; canned meats or egg mix; canned fruits and vegetables; and cheese.
