

SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM FOR SENIORS

The Elderly Commodity Food Program serves persons **60 years of age or older**. This does not include handicapped persons under 60 years of age. A person must reside within the geographical boundaries of **Polk, Warren, Jasper, Dallas, Madison, and Boone Counties**.

A person must meet the following income eligibility guidelines established by the United States Department of Agriculture as follows:

FOODS RECEIVED: Evaporated milk; non-fat dry milk; rice, macaroni or spaghetti; ready-to-eat cereal, farina, or oatmeal; peanut butter or dry beans; canned meats or egg mix; canned juices, fruits, and vegetables; and cheese.
