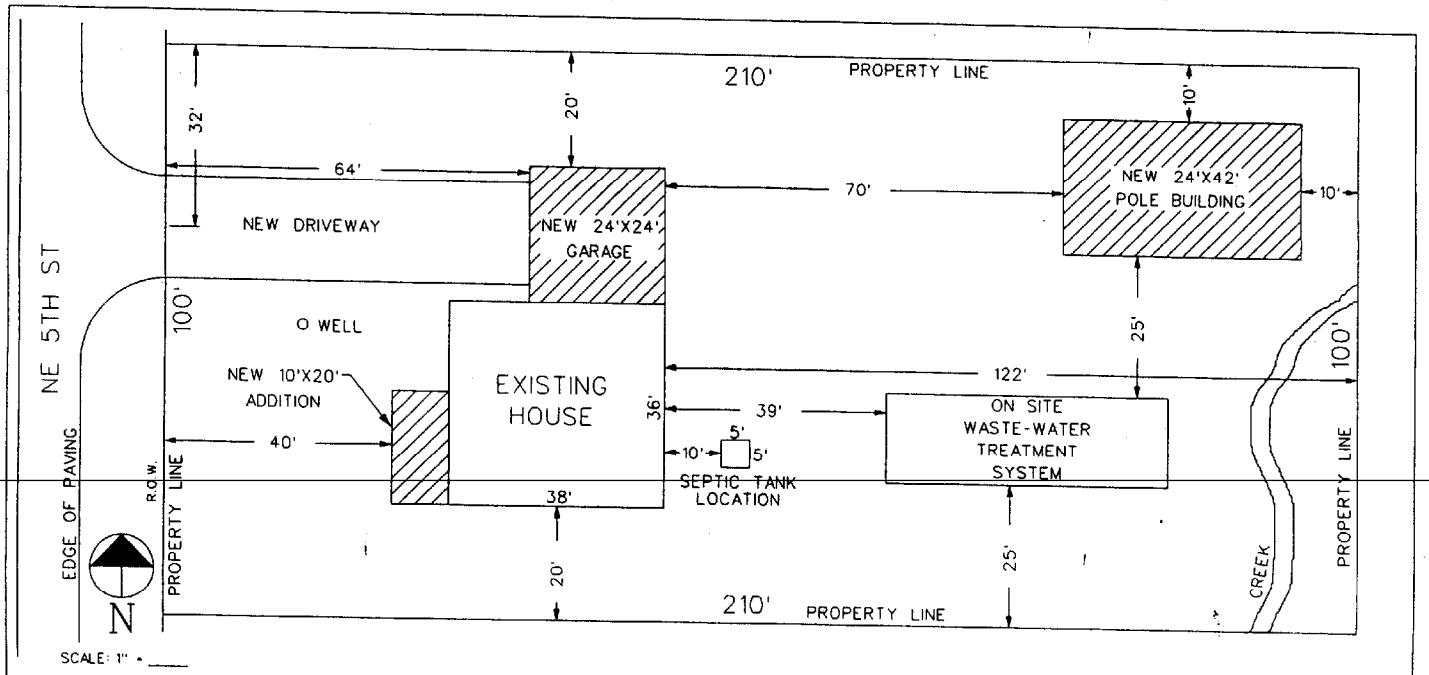


RESIDENTIAL SITE PLAN INSTRUCTIONS

Required Information:

1. Specify Site Address and Owner's Name.
2. Specify Name and Phone Number of person furnishing Site Plan information.
3. All streets must be identified.
4. Indicate Lot Dimensions.
5. All structures, existing and proposed, must be shown on the Site Plan. Dimensions of and distances to all lot lines from existing/proposed buildings must be indicated as well as distances between all proposed/and existing structures.
6. Indicate location of and distance to property entrance(s), existing and/or proposed. Dimensions from corner of property to center of drive should be indicated.
7. Indicate location of and distance to existing and proposed septic tank(s) and/or on site waste-water treatment system(s), if possible.
8. Indicate location of ponds, streams, drainage ways, and/or ravines. All physical features must be shown.
9. Identify North Directional Arrow and indicate scale of site plan.

Less than 120 ft², no permit required; less than 720 ft², no footing required.
Easements may affect minimum setback requirements.

ACCESSORY BUILDING SIZE

Building size cannot exceed maximum building coverage %. To find the buildable size of the property; take the square footage of the lot and multiply by the maximum coverage percentage to get total maximum building coverage. Then subtract all existing building square footage from the total maximum building coverage for lot, to get the maximum building square footage remaining on the lot.

Notes:

1. Businesses may not be conducted on a residential property unless the business meets and is approved for a Home Occupation Permit.
2. In NC, Suburban and Suburban Estate Districts accessory structures may not be placed in front of the principal building.
3. Accessory Building greater than 120 square feet must have a principal building on same lot.
4. Pools must be surrounded by solid wall, solid fence, or chain link fence not less than 5 ft. nor more than 6 ft. high.
5. Fences may not exceed: Front Yard – 4 ½ feet Height, Rear or Side Yard – 6 ½ feet height. Fences over 6 feet in height require a building permit.
