

A Democrat and Republican ballot, of the first rotation, appears in this publication and ballots of similarity shall appear in the proper precincts.

All qualified electors of the County of Polk are hereby notified to appear at said time and place and each voter to vote at the polling place designated or as authorized by law. All voters are also advised as to the requirements of voter registration in order to be eligible to vote at said election. This notice is given by order of the Polk County Commissioner of Elections. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. For further information, please contact the Polk County Election Office at 286-3247.
