

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is proposing to issue a modified Title V Operating Permit for Magellan Pipe Line Company, LLC- Des Moines Terminal. This facility is located at 2503 S.E. 43rd Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50327. DNR is currently reviewing a permit application submitted by Magellan Pipe Line Company, LLC- Des Moines Terminal to modify operations at their existing Gasoline Terminal/ Pipe Line Breakout Station, (SIC 4613).

Magellan Pipe Line Company, LLC- Des Moines Terminal is required to obtain a significant Title V Operating Permit modification pursuant to 567 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 22.113. This modification will result in a change to the facility's stack test requirement deadline for their Gasoline/Distillate Loading Rack, Submerged Normal, with Zeeco Model TFC-D-10 Vapor Combustor Unit (EU 1 / CE 1 / EP 1).

Based on the information provided in the application for Title V Operating Permit modification, the DNR has made an initial determination that the facility meets all the applicable criteria for the issuance of a significant permit modification specified in 567 IAC 22.107 and 567 IAC 113.

A complete record of the permit modification review, including the permit application and the proposed permit, is available for public inspection Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m., at the Polk County address shown above.

The public comment period for the draft permit modification will run from March 31, 2014 through April 30, 2014. The beginning date of this public comment period also serves as the beginning of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) 45-day review period, provided the EPA does not seek a separate review period. During this time, anyone may submit written comments on the draft permit. Mail signed comments to Jeff Gabby at the Polk County address shown above.

Written requests for a public hearing concerning the permit may also be submitted during the comment period. Any hearing request must state the person's interest in the subject matter, and the nature of the issues proposed to be raised at the hearing. DNR will hold a public hearing upon finding, on the basis of requests, a significant degree of relevant public interest in a draft permit. DNR will keep a record of the issues raised during the public participation process, and will prepare written responses to all comments received. The comments and responses will be compiled into a responsiveness summary document. After the close of the public comment period, DNR will make a final decision on the permit modification. The responsiveness summary and the final permit will be available to the public upon request.
