Testing at National HIV Testing day event 6/27 at Walgreen's on E. University from 3 - 7 pm. August is National Immunization Month. Suggestions were made to publicize the recent measles and pertussis outbreaks around the U.S. to highlight importance of immunizations. After discussion among board members, Rick will draft a letter of concern to bring back to July meeting on board's behalf to send to IDPH regarding the issue of exemptions for vaccinations.
