



PCHS COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

The PCHS Board has three standing committees, each of which meets monthly. The committees provide an in-depth review of issues relating to their respective areas. These issues are then brought to the full board for action. The committees are:

1. Executive Committee
2. System Outcomes Committee
3. System Improvement Committee

The Executive Committee functions as Board leadership, builds the Board meeting agendas, and acts as a gatekeeper, if necessary, for the System Improvement and System Outcomes Committees; referring information between committees, as needed. Each Executive Committee member also sits on either the System Improvement or System Outcomes Committee.

The System Outcomes Committee evaluates the Polk County disability system through reviewing quality assurance activities, system outcomes, and the activity report. The System Improvement Committee's role is to oversee Polk County's disability services through planning, overseeing implementation and development of services, and developing the budget. As new issues needing Board attention arise, the Executive Committee assigns them to either of these two committees.
