<u>Maternal Child Health Update</u> <i>By Stacey Jobs</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 34,376 children and 875 pregnant women were served by VNS of Iowa in FY2015 • 28,311 children participating in the EPSDT program <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Help them understand Medicaid, provide a medical home and transportation • 73% of Medicaid enrolled children 0-21 who receive at least one preventive health screen <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Numbers 14% down from FY2014 because started a new system • 70 % of 2 year olds Up-to-Date on Immunizations- 3% down from FY2014 • 93% of children who report a medical home- 1% up from FY2014 • 5,877 dental services provided • 87% of women receiving prenatal care beginning in the first trimester- 5% down from FY2014 • 90% of women delivering an infant at a healthy birth weight- 14% down from FY2014 • 86% of women who breastfed- 3% down from FY2014 • 98% of women who report a medical home at discharge- 6% up from FY2014 • Challenges- serving homeless people and mental illness
<u>Public Health Director Report (written report + comments)</u> <i>By Rick Kozin</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Under 8,000 flu shots given so far <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 431 adults with no insurance- huge drop this year ○ Uber offered flu shots. You call buy a \$10 dollar packet (including water bottle, etc.) and will give you a free flu shot up to 10 people. • Manage Care Organization contracts- Chris is reviewing. Deadline is Jan. 1st, 2016 • Roosevelt High School- we had 2 challenges 1. What made them sick? 2. Getting the correct message out. The media put out a report that it was food poisoning but we never determined it was.
<u>Board of Health/Board of Supervisors Action Review (written report + comments)</u> <i>By Scott Slater</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IDPH for Tuberculosis Program funding awarded is \$2,975. The per visit Direct Observed Therapy reimbursement has been reduced from \$25/visit to \$12.50/visit for newly diagnosed active cases, and the reimbursement cap from \$1,800 to \$900 per case. • IDPH for FY 16 Immunization Services Funding- The amount awarded is \$46,240, a 10% increase over the currently year's amount.
<u>Overview of Clinic and Lab Services</u> <i>By Leah Gabriel and Joelle Stolte</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical Services Provided and numbers served in FY 2015 - Chronic Disease Management (152), Healthy Woman Exams (132), Preventative Visits (43), Pre Employment physicals (354), school and athletic physicals (282), laboratory testing for immune status testing (49) and acute care (249) • Laboratory Services Provided and numbers completed in FY2015- Pregnancy Test (43), Flu (4), Urinalysis (188), Rapid Strep (42), CBC (32), urine drug screens (252), lead testing (127), MMR titers (25), Quant Golds (65), Pap Smears (98), Lipid Panels (211), Chemistry Panels (167) and Diabetes (76) • STD Laboratory test performed in FY2015- Herpes (143), Hep C (157), HIV (1084), Syphilis (1091) and GC/CH (3514)
