Nicotine products not approved by the FDA for tobacco cessation ▪ 19 of 25 Polk County school districts have policies ▪ Working to update Bondurant-Farrar’s policy and private school district policies • Ankeny Summerfest will be smoke free • Multi-Unit Housing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Over 100 properties in Polk County have a smoke free policy ▪ HUD Ruling- final on 2-3-17 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prohibits the use of tobacco products • Outdoor areas within 25ft of buildings • In all units, common areas and admin offices • Quitline Iowa- National Jewish Foundation serves as the contractor <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ FY2016 July-November 561 callers, 53 web users ▪ FY2017 July-November 221 callers and web users, 36 provider fax referrals • Tobacco-Free Worksites- Cassady Pharmacy, Bauder Pharmacy and Medicap Pharmacy (Ankeny)
<p><u>Public Health Director Report</u> <u>(written report + comments)</u> <i>By Rick Kozin</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Looking Ahead to 2017 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health Departments budget \$7,400,000 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 50% from local taxes, 40% from grants and 10% from fees and reimbursement • Our staff- 43.7 full time employees and 36 PRN <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 13 full time employees 100% county funded ▪ 5 full time employees 100% grant funded ▪ 22 full time employees grant/county funded • Highlights from 2016- Secured new 3-year lead hazard control grant from HUD, signed contracts with all 3 managed care companies, completed 2016 Health Report, completed 2nd School Immunization Audit Report, sent 2 Public Health Planners to Harvard, 3 articles in Polk County Medical Society Bulletin and high customer satisfaction feedback • Expectations for 2017- Higher priority to connect patients with a medical home, develop an STD prevention strategy, renovate 50 homes with lead hazards and implement strategic planning goals
