



(V-1)
 The Health Officer is authorized to issue a permit for an open fire for the following purposes. These permits may contain conditions and are subject to the provisions of Chapter V.

Authorization to permit an open fire will not be granted by the Health Officer when such conditions arise that would deem such fires to be a safety hazard. Permit fees may be established by resolution of the Polk County Board of Supervisors. Burn permit fees are currently \$126 plus \$13 for each inhabited building located within 1/4 mile of the proposed burn site.
