
Purpose: The purpose of the Right-of-Way Improvement Permit is to improve existing, deep county road ditches, to make them easier to mow for county residents, while still performing their intended function of conveying storm water from the roadway. The minimum existing ditch depth needed to quality for an improvement permit is shown in the detail below. An Entrance Permit is needed to widen an existing driveway entrance.

Owner Responsibilities: The owner is responsible for the following items: purchasing the corrugated metal pipe and accessories needed to install the pipe as identified by the County, installing the new pipe and making any connections to existing driveway culverts or sump discharges located in the ditch, backfilling, finish grading, seeding, and watering grass/seed to re-establish the ditch.
