Sealed bids for **ITB#2021-007 Jester Park RV Dump Station** in Polk County, Iowa will be received by the Polk County Conservation Board, 12130 NW 128th Street, Granger, Iowa, 50109. This project consists of all materials, equipment, and labor necessary to complete the project to construct two separate septic systems that will serve as the new RV dump station for the Jester Park campgrounds with a final completion date of October 15, 2021.

Bids will be received until **3:00.00 p.m., on Thursday, July 8, 2021 on BidNet Direct** <https://www.bidnetdirect.com/iowa/polkcounty>. The successful bidder shall be awarded the contract by Polk County Conservation Board at the **Polk County Conservation Board Meeting held at 5:30 p.m. on July 14th at the Polk County Administrative Building located at 111 Court Ave. Des Moines, IA 50309 room 110.**

Interested bidders may obtain bid packets from Polk County BidNetDirect.com <https://www.bidnetdirect.com/iowa/polkcounty> under ITB#2021-007 Jester Park RV Dump Station project.

Each bidder shall accompany the bid with a bid security as defined in Iowa Code section 26.8. The bid security must be in an amount set forth in the bidding documents and made payable to Polk County Conservation Board. Failure to execute a contract for the proposed work and file

an acceptable Performance Bond and Payment Bond in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price and a certificate of liability insurance within thirty days of the award of the contract will be just and sufficient cause for the rescinding of the award and the forfeiture of the bid security.

Sales tax exemption certificates will be issued to the successful bidder and its subcontractors for the purchase of materials and supplies related to this project.

By virtue of statutory authority, a preference will be given to products and provisions grown and produced within the State of Iowa and to Iowa domestic labor.
