## ATTENTION BOATERS

- Seasonal; “No Motorized Vessel Zone” North of the Mile Long Bridge
- When: April 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup> during periods of near normal conservation pools (Below 840’ NGVD).
- During periods of flood storage of 840’ NGVD elevation and rising, this motorized vessel restriction may be lifted until the lake returns to conservation pool.
- Non-motorized vessels including kayaks and canoes, are allowed.
- The area is posted with buoys and sign placard buoys.
- The zone represents approximately 1,400 surface acres; 600 acres of shallow island complex and 800 acres of shallow waters less than 2 feet in depth.
- The “No Motorized Vessel Zone” starts approximately 2,000 yards North of the Mile Long Bridge.

*The “mud flats” are a shallow water island complex, listed as a sensitive area in the Saylorville Lake Master Plan and is the largest contributor to Saylorville Lake’s globally significant designation as a bird conservation area by the American Bird Conservancy.*
