

SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM FOR SENIORS

The Elderly Commodity Food Program serves persons **60 years of age or older**. This does not include disabled people under 60 years of age. A person must reside within the geographical boundaries of **Polk, Warren, Jasper, Dallas, Story and Boone Counties**.

A person must meet the following income eligibility guidelines established by the United States Department of Agriculture as follows:

FAMILY SIZE	GROSS ANNUAL	GROSS MONTHLY
1	\$17,667	\$1,473
2	\$23,803	\$1,984
3	\$29,939	\$2,495
Additional member add:	+ \$6,136	+ \$512

Use gross amounts on all forms of income.

FOODS RECEIVED: Shelf stable milk, non-fat dry milk, rice or pasta, ready-to-eat cereal, farina, or oatmeal, peanut butter or dry beans, canned meat or fish, bottled juices, canned fruits, canned vegetables, and cheese.
