The Polk County Public Works Department has developed a plan to retrofit sanitary sewer mains and laterals in areas within unincorporated Polk County that can be served by the existing sanitary sewer capacity the County possesses. The plan outlines public improvements related to providing public sanitary sewer to replace aging, deteriorating, and sometimes failing onsite septic systems and promote economic development and alleviate blighting conditions. Polk County has determined that it would be fiscally prudent to provide funds to implement the 2022 Sanitary Sewer Improvements project, Phase 2 and identify costs to construct mains and connect properties along existing sanitary sewer mains, collectively. The Polk County Public Works Department has requested and received a Professional Services Agreement from the firm of Snyder & Associates to perform preliminary schematic design and cost estimates to implement the proposed improvements not to exceed the cost of \$202,000.

Background: Community, Family & Youth Services (CFYS) has identified the need for psychiatric and clinical consultation services at the Polk County Juvenile Detention Center. Dr. Randall Kavalier, a board certified child psychiatrist is uniquely qualified to provide these services. Youth who have past or current involvement with a psychiatrist are referred by nursing staff for an initial consultation. Dr. Kavalier also monitors youth on suicide precautions and advises staff when the level of precaution needs to be raised or lowered. Consultation will help to ensure that staff are informed about resident self-harm risk and recommended response, behavioral management interventions and overall child well-being. As Detention clientele continue to present with complex mental health and behavioral issues, the services of an on-site psychiatrist are extremely important for youth and staff. A Business Associate Agreement for these services is required to comply with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, 45 CFR §§ 164.308(b) and 164.504(e).

The total cost of this Agreement for all services shall not exceed \$55,000 per fiscal year. The term of this Agreement is July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025.

Action Impact: Approval of this Agreement for psychiatric services will help staff at the Detention Center continue to meet the emotional and behavioral needs of youth.

She will provide up to two hours per calendar week of medical services at PCJDC and will also be available for twenty-four-hour on-call consultation. Other responsibilities include: staff training, professional consultation with Detention staff members, and direct consultation with residents referred by a nurse or program administrator. The term of this Agreement is from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025. A Business Associate Agreement for these services is required to comply with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, 45 CFR 164.308(b).

Direct medical services are provided by a registered nurse and Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner (ARNP), but in the interest of best practices, the Detention Center desires to have all aspects of medical services under the supervision of a physician medical director. A Business Associate Agreement is also required in order to comply with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, 45 CFR 164.308(b) and 164.504(e). Services include but are not limited to:

- Establishment and/or review of medical policies and procedures to ensure high-quality care.
- Case reviews, including chart reading and discussing emerging medical issues as needed.
- Telephone consultation as necessary and backup coverage when the ARNP is scheduled to be away.
- Be knowledgeable of State of Iowa licensure requirements as they relate to Detention.
