Polk County has recently been awarded \$27,845,178.46 of reallocated ERA2 funds. This Fifth Amended Agreement is to provide IMPACT \$19,249,396.47 of those additional funds to continue assessing eligibility and distributing assistance consistent with Treasury rules. This Fifth Amended Agreement shall become effective upon signing and shall expire on December 31, 2025. SARA Volunteers shall be accessible 24 hours per day during the in-session school year, excluding breaks and holidays. This MOU shall be in effect until the end of the 2026-27 academic year.

**Previous Action Taken by the Board:** The Board previously affirmed a \$66.00 hourly rate for court appointed attorneys representing individuals in the above-described types of legal proceedings, most recently on August 17, 2021.

**Board/Commission Actions:** Polk County may be obligated to pay these court appointed attorney fees pursuant to a court order in cases where the parties are indigent.

Action Requested (Recommended): Approval

Comply with Policy: This action is necessary to pay hourly court appointed attorney fees in accordance with applicable Iowa Code sections (see, for example, Sections 229.8, 232.141, 331.424, 598.12B, and 815.7) and to help establish uniform and consistent hourly rates for these types of court cases.

**Background:** The Iowa legislature recently amended Iowa Code section 815.7 to provide that reasonable compensation for appointments of court attorneys made on or after July 1, 2022, shall be calculated on the basis of \$68.00 per hour, for cases not involving felony criminal charges. Polk County has now begun to receive judicial orders regarding payment to court appointed attorneys under the new law. To be consistent with state law and to avoid possible confusion, it is necessary to increase the hourly rate from \$66.00 to \$68.00.

**Action Impact:** This resolution represents a small increase in the hourly rate for court appointed attorney fees associated with guardianships, conservatorships, court visitors (guardian ad litems), mental health and substance abuse commitments, child custody investigators and child and family reporters.

**Fiscal Note:** There will be a relatively small increase in the amount of court appointed attorney fees paid by Polk County. Currently, there is a maximum attorney fee claim amount of \$200.00 (\$66.00 per hour x 3 hours) unless a Judge approves an order to exceed the guideline amount. Due to the hourly rate increase from \$66.00 to \$68.00, and to be consistent with the Iowa Administrative Code related to attorney fee limitations, the maximum attorney fee claim amount would now increase from \$200.00 to \$300.00, unless a Judge authorizes a greater amount.

The Credit is available for certain disabled veterans or their surviving spouse or child that satisfy specific statutory criteria. To receive this Credit, property owners must file a claim with the County Assessor, who then recommends allowance or disallowance of the claim to the County Auditor and County Board of Supervisors based upon the statutory criteria. Once allowed by the Board of Supervisors, the property owner must continue to satisfy the statutory criteria. If the property owner no longer satisfies the statutory criteria, the Credit should be cancelled. For taxable year 2022, payable in 2023 and 2024, the Assessor has identified one parcel that no longer qualifies for the Credit based upon application of statutory criteria. The Assessor recommends the Credit on the one parcel noted on the attached sheet be cancelled.


